UNDB Suggested by an NGO

The "Aichi Biodiversity Targets" adopted at the 10th Conference of the Parties to the Convention on Biological Diversity (CBD/COP10) held in Nagoya goes with a global framework of the "United Nations Decade on Biodiversity" (UNDB) that reinforce the implementation of the target. In suggesting this idea of the Decade through CBD to UN, Ramsar Network Japan (RNJ) intended to reinforce the implementation widening the field beyond the scope of the Convention.

RiceBED Project for the Implementation of Aichi Biodiversity Target

The "Rice-paddy Biodiversity Enhancement Decade" (RiceBED) project is a project that RNJ initiated for implementation of the UNDB and Aichi Biodiversity Target. The project is closely linked with other national frameworks for raising awareness to promote achievement of UNDB and Aichi Biodiversity Targets on the citizen level such as the "Japan Committee for UNDB" set up by the government and the "Double 20 Campaign" set up by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) Japan Committee. RiceBED Project provides a platform of awareness raising and participation for a wide variety of activities focused on enhancing rice paddy biodiversity.

Action Plan Guidebook

The RiceBED Project targets all agriculturalists, citizens, corporations and governments with an interest in rice paddy biodiversity. The booklet RiceBED Action Plan is a guidebook to encourage people in wet rice growing countries to establish their own plans adapted to their own rice paddy farming methods. However, the methods proposed by the guidebook will give some insights to people in other countries without rice paddies in their own planning for implementation of the Aichi Biodiversity Targets.

The Action Plan incorporates a comprehensive range of recognized actions in 18 rice paddy related targets linked with each Aichi Biodiversity Target. Participants are expected to choose, sign-up, and commit to carry out the activities they are competent to carry out from the Plan's list. RNJ will perform the work of summarizing the status of participant registration. The sum of all of these activities constitutes the RiceBED project.
